PRESS RELEASE

On April 1, 2024, a Complaint was filed in a case against the Edina Police Department and others involved, for several infringements against Mr. Kyle Moore's 4th Amendment Constitutional Rights. Mr. Moore was detained without cause, restrained by 11 officers for a total of eighteen minutes, and involuntarily injected with a dissociative anesthetic called Ketamine. As a result of being assaulted by 11 officers and being injected with Ketamine, Mr. Moore suffered many severe and life-threatening injuries. Mr. Moore suffered a Grand Mal seizure on the way to the hospital before being put into a medically induced coma for two days. Acute Hypoxic Respiratory Failure, Atelectasis, Aspiration Pneumonitis, Acute Toxic Metabolic Encephalopathy, acute kidney injury, high probability of imminent life or limb-threatening deterioration, Post Traumatic Stress Disorder, and other undisclosed injuries.

As a result of the incident, the Edina Police Department did falsely charge Mr. Moore with criminal charges to justify the assault that took place, but they were later dismissed as Mr. Moore had not done anything illegal. Before the assault, there were no charges pending regarding Mr. Moore, and there was no probable cause to pursue or arrest him. Mr. Moore is asking for monetary damages for the trauma and damage he incurred over this horrendous and traumatizing incident, as well as the medical issues which continue to this day as a result.
